Purpose?

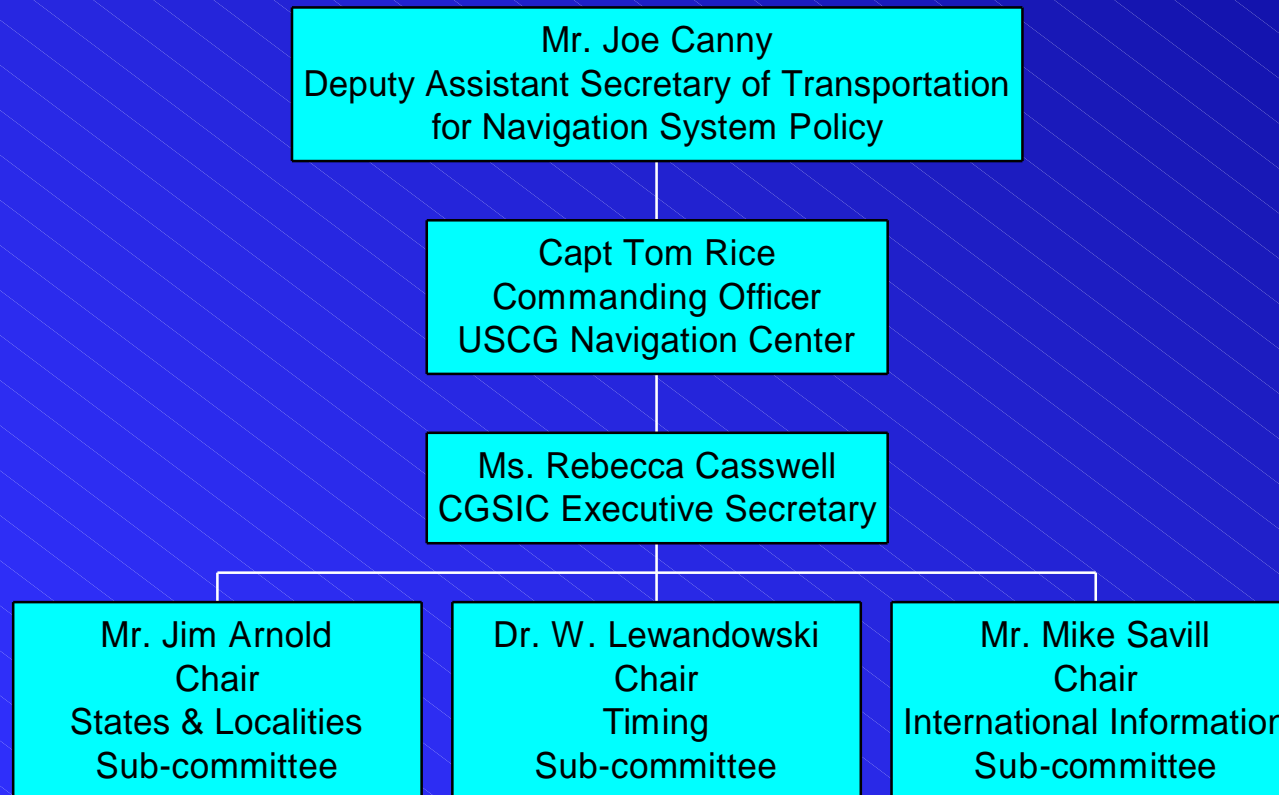
- To report civil user requirements to the Department of Transportation and the Interagency GPS Executive Brd for consideration in:

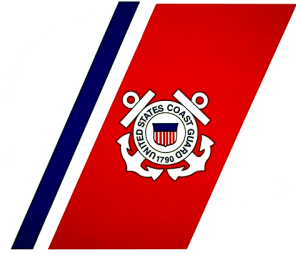
