Col Brandon C. Beers is the Deputy Director, National Coordination Office for Space-Based Position, Navigation, and Timing (PNT) at Headquarters U.S. Air Force, the Pentagon, Arlington, Virginia. He functionally supports the Deputy Secretaries of Defense and Transportation in their roles as the Co-Chairs of the National Executive Committee for Space-Based PNT. He is responsible for coordinating across the federal government to ensure that PNT policies, programs, budgets, and activities address national priorities as well as military requirements.

Col Beers entered the Air Force as a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Officer Training School in 2001 and transferred to the U.S. Space Force in August 2021. His career has spanned a wide variety of program management, leadership, and staff positions within the Air Force, Space Force, Joint Staff, and the National Reconnaissance Office. His assignments include serving as Deputy Program Manager, Program Manager, Executive Officer, Program Element Monitor, and Materiel Leader. Col Beers also deployed in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM and OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM as the Executive Officer to the Commander, 379th Expeditionary Maintenance Group.
